## ROUND ROBIN GUIDELINES

If the number or teams in a division size falls below 8 , the tournament committee may decide to use a Round Robin format instead of the traditional 'A side / B side' format. For 2017, Round Robins will be held for the following divisions:

- Bantam C (6 teams):
o 2 pools of 3 teams
o Teams in each pool play each other once (games BC1-BC6) **
o $1^{\text {st }}$ in Pool A plays $1^{\text {st }}$ in Pool B in a championship final (game BC7)
$0 \quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ in Pool A plays $2^{\text {nd }}$ in Pool B in a final (game BC8)
- Midget A (6 teams):
o 2 pools of 3 teams
o Teams in each pool play each other once (games MA1-MA6) **
$0 \quad 1^{\text {st }}$ in Pool A plays $1^{\text {st }}$ in Pool B in a championship final (game MA7)
** Non-final round robin games may end in a tie - no overtimes or shootout **
Tie breakers (to be applied in order):

1. Most game points (2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, 0 points for a loss)
2. Head to head record (all teams must have played each other equal times)
3. Most games won
4. Greatest total goal differential (GF-GA)
5. Fewest penalty minutes (3 for minors, 7 for majors, 10 for all others)
6. Coin flip or tournament committee decision
